1. Introduction

The Archer Protect, Inc. is a fraud prevention company offering its services to its customers, and other users of its website and services. Archer offers a robust set of tools to assist partners in performing risk assessments during critical user interactions such as sign ups, loan requests and other transactions

We understand that you are aware of and care about your personal privacy interests, and we take that seriously.

This Privacy Notice describes the personal data we may collect about you when you visit our website, social media sites, or any other way that you interact with us. We recognize that information privacy is an ongoing responsibility, and so we will from time to time update this Privacy Notice as we undertake new personal data practices or adopt new privacy policies. We will notify you when we make a change, and visitors will know this by checking the last date of the update on this page whenever they visit.

The word “You” or “Your” relates to our data subject, or visitors of our website or end-users of our customers/partner’s service.

2. Data Protection Officer

- 2.1. Archer Protect, Inc. has appointed a Data Protection Officer who has the responsibility to monitor how we comply with our obligations as stipulated by law and advises Archer how to carry out processing in line with the law.
- 2.2. Archer Protect, Inc is also a Data Controller with regards to the processing of non-direct "End-User Personal Data"
- 2.3. Archer has appointed a Data Protection Officer who you can contact about every issue regarding the processing of your personal data and the exercise of your right. 3. How and why we collect and use (process) your personal information

- 3.1. Archer may receive the following personal data about You from our partners: Name, Address, contact information, Date of birth, Photograph, Bank Verification Number (BVN), Bank account details, Transaction history, National Identification number, Location data, and any other information as may be required.
- 3.2. We use these personal data to help our partners identify you, prevent and detect fraud. We may also use your IP address and other information to identify you, enhance our services, provide customer support, analyse website traffic and provide information on service updates and prospects.
- 3.3. Archer processes your personal data based on our legitimate interest to prevent fraud, build a database, and protect our business and Partners.
- 3.4. We do not knowingly attempt to solicit or receive personal information from Children.
- 3.5. From time to time, Archer Protect, Inc. receives personal information about individuals from partners. We may also collect your personal data from a third party website (e.g. LinkedIn, corporate registry)

4. Lawful basis for processing data

4.1 Archer Protect, Inc. has a legitimate interest in processing your personal data to prevent fraud and protect our business. Processing your data is essential for our own legitimate interests or those of our third-party partners, unless your rights and freedoms outweigh our interests. In that case, we cannot rely on this lawful basis for processing. We may also process your personal data based on our legitimate interest to analyse usage and improve the functionality of our Website.

4.2. We may process your personal data where you have given explicit consent for us to process your data for a specific purpose such as to receive our marketing communication, and to install non-strictly necessary cookies on your device.

4.3. Archer Protect, Inc. may process your personal data where we have a legal obligation to do so. For example, to interact with regulatory authorities concerning you.

4.4. We may process your data to fulfil the terms of contract we have executed with you.

5. Use of the Archer Protect, Inc. Website

5.1. As is true of most other websites, Archer Protect, Inc.'s website collects certain information automatically and stores it in log files. The information may include internet protocol (IP) addresses, the region or general location where your computer or device is accessing the internet, browser type, operating system, duration as well as frequency of website visits and other usage information about the use of Archer Protect, Inc.'s website, including a history of the pages you view.

5.2. We use this information to help us design our site to better suit our users' needs. We may also use your IP address to help diagnose problems with our server and to administer our website, analyze trends, track visitor movements, understand how you and potential customers use its website, and gather broad demographic information that assists us in identifying visitor preferences. This assists Archer Protect, Inc. with providing more relevant products and services, with communicating value to our customers and with providing appropriate staffing to meet customer needs.

6. Cookies and tracking technologies

6.1. We typically collect this information through a variety of tracking technologies including cookies, flash objects, web beacons, file information and similar technologies ("**tracking technologies**");

6.2. We may use the data collected through tracking technologies to:

6.2.1. Remember information so that you will not have to re-enter it during your visit or the next time you visit our website or mobile application;

6.2.2. Provide custom, personalised content and information, including targeted content and advertising;

- 6.2.3. Identify you across multiple devices;
 - 6.2.4. Provide and monitor the effectiveness of our Services;
 - 6.2.5. Monitor aggregate metrics such as the total number of visitors, traffic, usage and demographic patterns on our Services;
 - 6.2.6. Diagnose or fix technology problems and otherwise plan for and enhance our Services;
- 6.3. 7. Sharing information with third parties

- 7.1.** Your Personal data will be primarily processed by Archer for the above listed purposes. Please note that we may share your personal data with our Partners, a list of our partners ranges from service providers, financial institution partners, integration tools providers, payment processors, and public database providers.
- 7.2.** The personal data Archer Protect, Inc. collects from you is stored in one or more secured databases hosted by third parties. These service providers do not use or have access to your personal information for any purpose other than cloud storage and retrieval. On occasion, Archer Protect, Inc. engages third parties who are facilitating the delivery of our services to send information to you, including information about our products, services, and events.
We take your Privacy seriously and as such we do not sell or rent your personal information to anyone and do not use your data other than for the purposes covered under this notice.
- 7.3.** The personal data you have provided, we have collected from you or have received from a third party, will be used to prevent fraud and protect the business of Archer and its Partners.

7.4. We do not otherwise reveal your personal data to non-Archer Protect, Inc. persons or businesses for their independent use unless: (1) you request or authorise it; (2) the information is provided to comply with the law (for example, compelled by law enforcement to comply with a search warrant, subpoena, or court order), enforce an agreement we have with you, or to protect our rights, property or safety, or the rights, property or safety of our employees or others; (3) the information is provided to our partners, or service providers who perform functions on our behalf; (4) to address emergencies or acts of God; or (5) to address disputes, claims, or to persons demonstrating legal authority to act on your behalf. We may also gather aggregated data about our services and website visitors and disclose the results of such aggregated (but not personally identifiable) information to our partners, service providers, advertisers, and/or other third parties for marketing or promotional purposes.

8. Transferring personal data.

8.1. Archer Protect, Inc. has its headquarters in the United States. Information we collect about you will be transferred in accordance with the Nigeria Data Protection Act and other relevant data protection legislation.

8.2. Depending on the circumstance, Archer Protect, Inc. also collects and transfers to the U.S. personal data with consent; to perform a contract with you; or to fulfill a compelling legitimate interest of Archer Protect, Inc. in a manner that does not outweigh your rights and freedoms. Archer Protect, Inc. endeavours to apply suitable safeguards to protect the privacy and security of your personal data and to use it only consistent with your relationship with Archer Protect, Inc. and the practices described in this Privacy Notices. Archer Protect, Inc. also enters into data processing agreements and model clauses with its Partners whenever feasible and appropriate.

9. Data Subject rights

9.1. The Nigeria Data Protection Act and other relevant data protection laws provide certain rights for data subjects. Data Subject rights under GDPR include the following:

9.1.1. Right to be informed: you have a right to be informed about the processing activities that require your personal data. This is why we have provided you with this Privacy Notice for your information.

- 9.1.2. Right of access: you have a right to confirm if we process your personal data and access it or be provided a copy. Access to a copy of your personal data will be provided to you at no cost. If access cannot be provided within a reasonable time frame, Archer Protect, Inc. will provide you with a date when the information will be provided. If for some reason access is denied, Archer Protect, Inc. will promptly provide an explanation as to why access has been denied.
- 9.1.3. Right to rectification: you have a right to update or correct your personal data that is incomplete or inaccurate
- 9.1.4. Right to erasure: you have a right to have your personal data erased or deleted from our database
- 9.1.5. Right to restrict processing: you have a right to ask us to temporarily suspend the processing of your personal data
- 9.1.6. Right of data portability: you have a right to receive or ask us to transmit your personal data to another entity in a structured, commonly-used, and machine-readable format
- 9.1.7. Right to object processing: you have a right to object to us processing your data
- 9.1.8. Rights related to automated decision-making including profiling: you have a right to ask that your personal data is not processed to make solely automated decisions about you, including profiling
- 9.1.9. Right to withdraw consent: where we process your personal data based on your consent, you can withdraw the consent at any time you wish
- 9.1.10. Right to lodge a complaint: If your rights are not satisfactorily addressed, you may lodge a complaint with the Nigeria Data Protection Commission (NDPC)

10. Data storage and retention

- 10.2.** Archer Protect, Inc. retains prospect data until such time as it no longer has business value and is purged from Archer Protect, Inc. systems. All personal data that Archer Protect, Inc. controls may be deleted upon verified request from Data Subjects or their authorised agents.
